Annual Report: 2022-2023

Established in 2018, the Government College for Women, Shahzadpur is affiliated with Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra which is a NAAC accredited A+ grade university. The college is situated at the border of Haryana which is adjacent to Himachal and is thus quite near to the majestic Himalayas. The clean air, greenery, and rustic environs around the college provide a pleasant change that can be felt by any newcomer. The college boasts a spacious building and is well equipped with modern infrastructural facilities to cater to the needs of girl students from rural areas as well as the staff. The college is spread over 09 acres of land and is specially designed by keeping in mind the needs of differently-abled persons and has ramps and washrooms suitable for them. It has twenty-one spacious classrooms, one conference hall, a well-furnished library, and seven functional laboratories belonging to Computer Science, Language, Psychology, Geography, Physics, and Chemistry. The college has ample space for sports-ground, has a mini gymnasium, a common room, and soon to be fully ready multi-purpose hall, well-maintained parks, RO water facility, separate and clean toilets for girls and staff on every floor, parking areas for vehicles (separate for students), a college canteen, a well-furnished and ventilated staff-room and departmental rooms. All these are essential parts of the basic infrastructure which make the process of education pleasant and endearing. At the Under-Graduate level, the College runs three regular streams- Humanities, Non-Medical Sciences, and Commerce, along with a Vocational Course in Computer Applications. It offers a choice of eleven subjects for the students of Humanities; General and Computer Application for the students of Commerce; and Non-Medical with Computer Application for the students of the Science stream. At the postgraduate level, the college has Masters in Commerce which commenced in 2022. Presently a total number of 766 girl students are studying here and two batches of the students have already graduated from the college.

The credibility is well earned during the last five years of its existence. The same can further be verified from many applications for admission which get turned down due to a limited number of seats. This manifests the demand amongst the students for the college which is due to their faith in the safe and gender-sensitive environment in which the college operates and offers qualitative education to the students. A dedicated and diligent team of teaching and non-teaching staff (Twenty-four teaching and eighteen non-teaching (regular and contractual) which includes five members under NAAPS perform their duties under the competent guidance

of the Principal. The collective efforts have ensured regular classes for students and have brought laurels to the College in both academic and non-academic fields.

The College, being a government institute, receives several Annual Grants-in-Aid such as a Library Grant, Passport Grant, Women Cell Grant, Road Safety Grant, Augmentation of Laboratories, Earn-While-You-Learn, Assistance for science Exhibition, Placement Cell, etc. for different activities and purposes. During the session 2022-2023, the college has utilized approximately 3,38,675/- rupees worth of grants.

The institute aims to empower girl students not only in an academic way but also to target their overall grooming. The college has the privilege of bagging many prizes at District, Zonal and Divisional Levels.

Though a new college, the college is the first one to upload All India Survey on Higher Education (AISHE) data on the MHRD portal. The college has been registered with NAAC and SHREYAS (Scheme for Higher Education Youth for Apprenticeship and Skills). The Internal Quality Assurance Cell regularly conducts meetings and takes steps to ensure requisite quality standards.

The collective vision of the college is to create a generation with good moral values, high cultural values, and a continuing tradition of students who take pride in being Indian; students and teachers who are committed to and can learn and align these qualities with the changing world to have a successful future. Limitations

- Transportation is still a limitation. Adequate bus services are not available for all the rural routes (the college is situated in a rural area) and as per the college timings. Also, proper sheds are not available at nearby bus stops and students have to wait in sunlight (especially during summer) for the buses. The college has taken up the issue with the concerned authorities and is hopeful that desired steps would be taken shortly.

- The college auditorium or the multi-Purpose Hall is yet to get facilities like soundproofing and stage flooring. Due to some procedural reasons, the work has been delayed. The college is coordinating with the concerned authorities and we are expecting that the work will be completed at the earliest.
- The college has ample open space which could be utilized as a sports ground. The college has taken steps to develop a sports ground with some facilities and because of this, we have been able to conduct annual sports meets. However, converting this space into a proper sports ground requires assistance from the PWD/Government and the college is working in this direction.
- Faculty is not available as per the workload in some of the subjects like English, Sciences, Hindi, etc. The college has intimated the authorities regarding the same and we are expecting that the required action would be taken at the earliest.

Strengths

- Despite the above-mentioned limitations, the college has taken huge strides toward achieving its goals. The staff of the college has been working with full enthusiasm and commitment. The staff has been organizing various events to popularize the college and to make girls in the area understand the worth of education and due to their diligent efforts, the college has been able to create demand among the students and parents. In the end, we can assure that whatever shortcomings are still there, will be overcome shortly. It is just a matter of time. The college is still in its infancy as it was established in 2018 only and it does take time for every good thing to get established and same goes for this college.
